PART 1: REMOVING YOUR FRONTAL WIG

STEP 1: GATHER YOUR SUPPLIES

YOU'LL NEED:

**LACE ADHESIVE REMOVER (OR 91%
ISOPROPYL ALCOHOL OR OIL-BASED
REMOVER)**

COTTON PADS OR Q-TIPS

RAT-TAIL COMB


MILD SHAMPOO AND CONDITIONER

WIG STAND OR MANNEQUIN HEAD

STEP 2: SOFTEN THE ADHESIVE

SPRAY OR DAB LACE ADHESIVE REMOVER ALONG YOUR HAIRLINE (WHERE THE LACE MEETS YOUR SKIN).

LET IT SIT FOR 2-5 MINUTES TO BREAK DOWN THE GLUE OR GEL.

GENTLY PRESS WITH A COTTON PAD — IF IT STARTS LIFTING, YOU'RE READY.

STEP 3: GENTLY LIFT THE LACE

START AT ONE CORNER AND SLOWLY PEEL BACK THE LACE USING YOUR FINGERS OR THE TAIL OF YOUR COMB.

NEVER PULL HARD — IF YOU FEEL RESISTANCE, APPLY MORE REMOVER AND WAIT A MINUTE.

 **TIP: ALWAYS REMOVE IN SECTIONS, NOT ALL AT ONCE. THIS PREVENTS LACE TEARING OR HAIRLINE DAMAGE.**

STEP 4: CLEAN YOUR LACE

**ONCE THE WIG IS OFF, LAY IT LACE-SIDE UP
ON A CLEAN TOWEL.**

**USE A COTTON PAD SOAKED WITH
ADHESIVE REMOVER TO WIPE AWAY
LEFTOVER GLUE FROM THE LACE.**

**GENTLY WASH THE LACE AREA WITH MILD
SHAMPOO, RINSE, AND AIR-DRY ON A WIG
STAND.**

STEP 5: CLEAN YOUR SKIN

**USE A BIT OF REMOVER OR ALCOHOL TO
WIPE OFF GLUE RESIDUE FROM YOUR
FOREHEAD.**

**WASH YOUR HAIRLINE WITH GENTLE SOAP
OR CLEANSER, THEN MOISTURIZE LIGHTLY.**

  **PART 2:**

REAPPLYING YOUR FRONTAL WIG

STEP 1: PREP YOUR NATURAL HAIR

**BRAID OR SLICK BACK YOUR HAIR SO IT LIES
FLAT.**

**CLEAN YOUR SKIN WITH ALCOHOL OR WITCH
HAZEL TO REMOVE OIL AND MAKEUP.**

STEP 2: PREPARE THE WIG

**MAKE SURE YOUR LACE IS CLEAN AND DRY.
CUT ANY EXCESS LACE IF NEEDED (ONLY A
LITTLE BIT AT A TIME).**

**APPLY FOUNDATION OR LACE TINT TO THE
UNDERSIDE OF THE LACE TO MATCH YOUR
SKIN TONE**

STEP 3: APPLY ADHESIVE OR GEL

YOU CAN USE:

LACE GLUE (FOR LONG WEAR, 1-3 WEEKS)

**GOT2B GEL OR SPRAY (FOR SHORT-TERM, 1-3
DAYS)**

STEPS:

**APPLY A THIN, EVEN LAYER OF ADHESIVE ALONG
YOUR NATURAL HAIRLINE.**

LET IT DRY UNTIL TACKY (ALMOST CLEAR).

**OPTIONALLY APPLY A SECOND LAYER FOR
STRONGER HOLD.**

STEP 4: POSITION THE WIG

**ALIGN THE LACE WITH YOUR NATURAL
HAIRLINE.**

**GENTLY PRESS THE LACE INTO THE TACKY
ADHESIVE, STARTING AT THE CENTER AND
MOVING OUTWARD.**

**USE A RAT-TAIL COMB TO PRESS THE LACE
DOWN FOR A SEAMLESS MELT.**

STEP 5: SECURE AND STYLE

TIE A SILK SCARF OR ELASTIC BAND AROUND YOUR HAIRLINE FOR 10–15 MINUTES TO SET THE LACE.

ONCE SET, STYLE AS DESIRED — CURL, STRAIGHTEN, OR LAY BABY HAIRS.

STEP 6: MAINTAIN DAILY

WRAP YOUR HAIRLINE WITH A SILK SCARF AT NIGHT.

AVOID GETTING THE LACE TOO WET IF USING GLUE.

USE A LIGHT OIL OR WIG SERUM TO KEEP THE HAIR SOFT AND SHINY.

Don't miss...

Important tips for smooth removal....

✨ 1. Always remove old glue completely.

Re-gluing over residue causes tackiness and uneven application. Use adhesive remover and gently scrub until the lace feels smooth.

✨ 2. Let the lace dry fully before applying glue.

Moisture under the lace = weak hold + white residue.

✨ 3. Avoid oil-based products near the hairline.

Oils break down glue faster and cause lifting. Apply serums only to mid-lengths and ends.

✨ 4. Use thin glue layers and let them go clear.

Rushing this step creates a gummy, messy hairline.

✨ 5. Re-tint the lace lightly each time.

Old makeup or buildup on the lace edge can dull your melt — a fresh coat of lace tint or foundation keeps it seamless.

✨ 6. Seal lace edges if they start fraying.

Use a tiny bit of Fray Check or clear fabric glue to stop small tears before they spread.

✨ 7. Give your wig a “rest” day.

Let it air out and sit on a wig stand between wears to keep the lace soft and flexible.

✨ 8. Use a melt band every time you reapply.

It reactivates the glue's grip and gives that fresh, “just installed” salon look.
